Audience Comments on Agenda Items

Audience comments were taken out of order

Ms. Ross from the Native Plant and Wildflower Club of Trilogy Orlando stated that they conducted a test patch to the left of the pickle ball courts and behind the pool building. This was approved by the HOA. The next goal is to include District areas such as by the power lines and/or retention areas. She also indicated that flowers are mowed no more than twice a year.

Mr. Szulwach provided a map to the Board indicating the desired test patch locations.

Ms. Ross added that they contacted the St. Johns River Water Management District and received permission in writing to plant wildflowers in the dry retention areas.

They have worked along with and have been receiving guidance from Ecological Solutions.

The most common plants are Black Eyed Susan, Coreopsis, and Blanket flowers.

Mr. Schultheis expressed concern regarding planting on the slopes causing an erosion issue.

This project would be funded with grants.

Ms. McMican expressed concern regarding the cost of getting land back to its original state if the project is unsuccessful.

Ms. Mackie suggested a waiver of liability for individuals and a short form license agreement for vendors.

This item will be added to the next agenda and further discussed.
